CATEGORIES FOR ORGANISING CHILDREN'S BOOKS

- Alphabetised
- Author
- Colour

- Topic
- Non-fiction

ORGANISING IDEAS

- * Use baskets or boxes to separate different book categories
- * Use bookends on large bookshelves to hold bigger collections of books
- * Add picture or word labels to baskets or boxes to make it easier for kids to find what they're after
- * Alternatively, use different coloured stickers to differentiate categories
- * Mixing up how you stack the books, either horizontally or vertically, makes it easier for children to sift through and make a selection
- * If you're lacking bookshelf storage space, remove seasonal books (i.e. Christmas, Easter, Halloween) and bring them back out when the holiday approaches
